- Provide in-person laboratory experience through a visit to UNBC's Prince George campus.
- Increased university participation among learners in Northern BC and across the province.

Features:

Throughout the 2021/22 school year, EBUS Science Cohort students will be able to:

- Interact with and learn from UNBC Professors, current students, as well as EBUS science specialists;
- Observe select university lectures in real-time, and recorded;
- Win prizes for their participation in EBUS Science Cohort events;
- Visit UNBC in-person for a multi-day experience to complete high school laboratory classes, tour the campus and surrounding grounds, and otherwise "live life" just as a UNBC student would.
